The Asian-Oceanian Society of Neuroradiology and Head & Neck Radiology (AOSNHNR) is a federation made up of 19 member societies. We are an organization of physicians specializing in the field of neuroradiology and head and neck radiology.

Discussion started in 1994, when there was a growing need for a society based in Asian and Oceanian countries. It was the time of the International Congress of Radiology in Singapore, held in January 1994, when the representatives got together and met for the first organizational meeting. They discussed the structure of the society and its constitution. The AOSNHNR was then officially founded later in the same year in Kumamoto, Japan.

What are the purposes of this society?

- We hold meetings every two years in various cities (see below).
- We promote speakers to international meetings, including but not limited to ASNR, AOSR and SNR.
- · We provide educational materials both online and offline.
- · We work in collaboration with the World Federation of Neuroradiological Societies (WFNRS).



Our meetings (also known as Asian-Oceanian Congress of Neuroradiology, AOCNR) will be held every two years. This will be a great opportunity for you to present your latest work. There will be speakers from all around the world.
