## AOCR-IRIA Chennai, India, January 2025 (AOSOR program)

And other lectures from IRIA partners on 'Imaging in Parkinson related disorder, Imaging biomarkers in differentiating Neurocysticercosis and Tuberculoma and Imaging update in diagnosis and therapeutic response assessment of skull base osteomyelitis'.


