

11-Eurasian Radiological Congress, Astana, Kazakhstan, June 2025

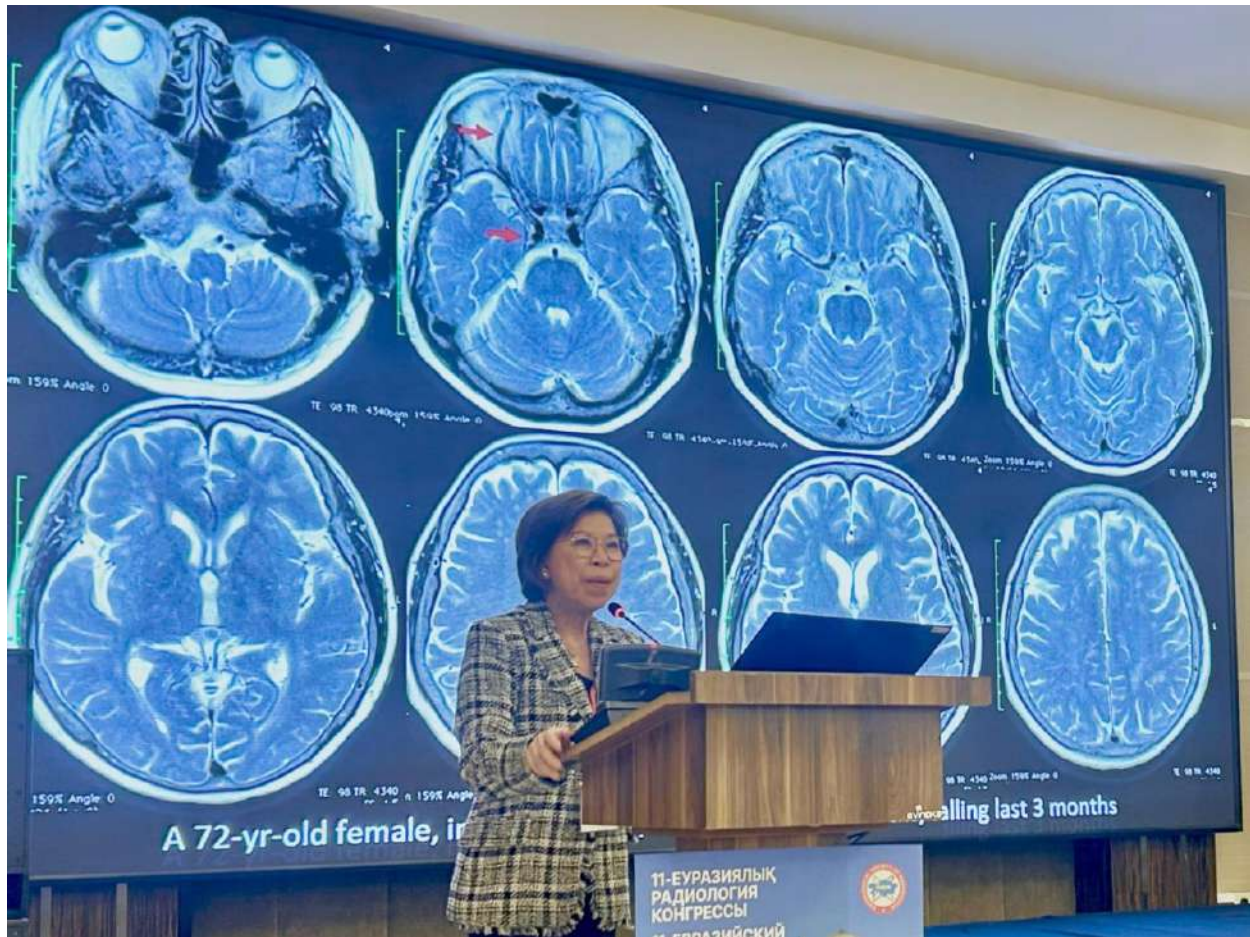
